

## **Care Instructions for Rental Skin Suits**

The skin suit material is very sensitive. **Follow these instructions carefully.** 

## AVOID ALL CONTACT WITH VELCRO.

- To avoid velcro on other equipment, use a fabric bag or pillow case when storing skin suit in equipment bag.
- Be careful of the suit when wearing neck guards or gloves with velcro tabs on the wrists.

**DO NOT WASH SKIN SUIT.** Due to the sensitivity of the fabric, the club will wash all rental suits between uses.

**PROTECT THE FABRIC! DO NOT** allow skater to crawl on the floor or play on equipment when wearing the suit (wear pants over suit when not skating);

**DO NOT** use bathroom hand dryers on the suit (the plastic in the fabric will melt under the intense heat).

**DO NOT** use hair dryers on the suit. (The only exception to this rule is if the hair dryer clearly has a 'no heat' option).

**DO NOT** pull white Dynema lining down over the back of skates because it will stretch and tear the fabric. Separate Kevlar or Dynema ankle guards should always be used for ankle protection.

All suits will be inspected upon return of the rental for any damage beyond normal wear and tear, and as noted on our registration form, families may be responsible for the costs of any repair to the suit.
